The 26th Annual Southeast District 4-H Dairy Show was held August 27 at the Allentown Fair Grounds. Nine counties participated in the event.

In Ayrshire competition, a six-year old cow, Ardrossan GLR Minerva, owned by Eddie Hen-

ley was named grand champion. He also showed a senior yearling heifer that won reserve junior championship honors. Eddie is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Kennard Henley, Cochranville. Eddie's sister, Sharon, exhibit-

ed the junior champion Ayrshire, a senior heifer calf.

Reserve grand champion Ayrshire was a four-year old cow, Eureka Majestic Mad, shown by Tina Kulp, Pottstown. Tina

is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Harold Kulp.

Chester County Ayrshire exhibitors also showed the first place county group of four animals.

Nancy Wollaston, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Wollaston, Toughkenamon, won champion Jersey honors with her three-year old cow, Milad Maple Lawn Pollyanna. Junior champion Jersey was an intermediate heifer calf exhibited by James Wertz, Downingtown. The first place county group of four Jer-

seys also was an entry by Chester County exhibitors.

In Guernsey competition, reserve grand champion honors were awarded to a junior yearling heifer, Sunbeam Princess Debbie, shown by Deborah Gray, Downingtown. Debbie is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Willard Gray. Reserve senior champion Guernsey was a two-year old cow shown by Robert Shoff, Oxford. Chester County exhibitors also showed the first place county group of four Guernseys.

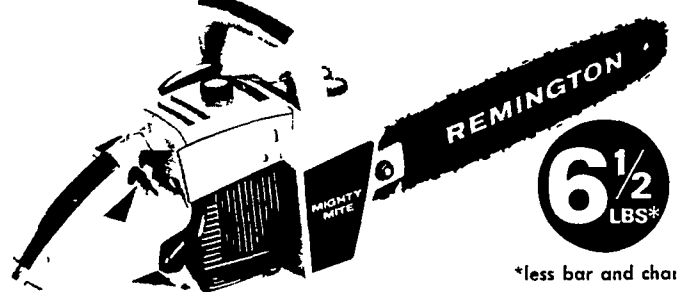
