



Pennsylvanians Join Holstein Assn.

Pennsylvania, with 284 individuals and firms recently joining the Holstein-Friesian Association of America, has the second largest new membership in the national Holstein organization.

New York state edged Pennsylvania by one member on the current roster of new members. Wisconsin is third in new members with 274.

These new members join the ranks of nearly 28,000 people actively breeding Registered Holstein-Friesian cattle who enjoy reduced rate when registering and transferring their animals. In addition, they gain a voice in developing policy for the

breed by selecting delegates to their national convention as well as having representation on the board of directors of HFAA.

The goal of every member is to attain the title of "breeder" which, in livestock circles, suggests a special kind of dairyman, one who excels in improving the genetic base of his herd. This excellence is achieved through superior management and is complemented by the official performance programs which evaluate production and functional conformation to each animal. 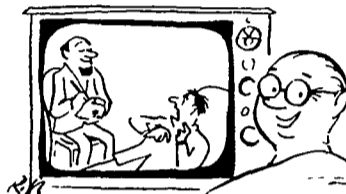

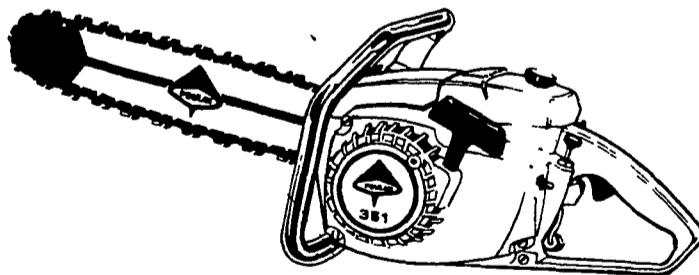
