Guernsey Breeders Give Awards

About 75 persons attended the annual banquet meeting of the Lancaster County Guernsey Breeders Association at the Harvest Drive Restaurant last Friday.

Three new directors elected were: Robert Breneman, Strasburg; Robert McSparran, Peach Bottom, and Elam Mull, Mechanics Grove.

The group heard a report from the owner of the Guernsey Restaurant at New Holland.

K. D. Linde, Oxford RD1, gave a slide presentation on "Germany As Seen in 1971."

Dennis Nolt, New Holland, who received the FFA Guernsey calf, gave a progress report.

Awards for high milk and butterfat production were awarded as follows:

High herd average, Penn-Del Farm, Raymond and Louise Witmer, Willow Street, 12,129 pounds of milk and 601 pounds of butterfat, for a 5.0 per cent test from 54 cows. Second high herd average was Lindenhof Farm, K. D. Linde, 11,887 pounds of milk and 539 pounds of butterfat, a 4.5 per cent test on 45.4 cows.

High records for individual cows were reported as follows:

High two-year old milk production, Romella Farm, Strasburg RD1, 11,812 pounds of milk, with 493 pounds of butterfat and 4.2 per cent test.

High two-year old butterfat, Penn-Del Farm, 631 pounds of butterfat, with 11,532 pounds of milk and a 5.5 per cent test.

High three-year old milk, Romella Farm, 14,397 pounds of

milk, with 540 pounds of butterfat and a 3.8 per cent test

Three-year old butterfat, White Plains Farm, Kirkwood, 669 pounds of butterfat, with 14,025 pounds of milk and 4.8 per cent test.

Four-year old milk and butterfat, Greenfield Farm, John N Landis, Lancaster, 15,512 pounds of milk and 678 pounds of butterfat, with a 4.4 per cent test.

High aged cow milk production, Lindenhof Farm, 17,378 pounds of milk, with 735 pounds of butterfat and a 4.2 per cent test.

Aged cow high butterfat average, Penn-Del Farm, 796 pounds of butterfat, with 15,045 pounds of milk and a 5.3 per cent average

Fix-It Tip

To keep your expensive tools from rusting in basement dampness or when storing them in the garage, wrap them in heavy aluminum foil. Lubricate them before wrapping. Lubrication will not dry out in the foil.

If a flat tire, empty gas tank or dead battery stalls you on a dark road at night, you can make a warning signal by stretching a long sheet of aluminum foil along the back and side of your car nearest the road. Secure the foil by closing the car doors or windows on it. The foil will reflect the headlights of oncoming cars and could be a lifesaver.
