encouraged a caravan of Pennsylvania people to buy milk in

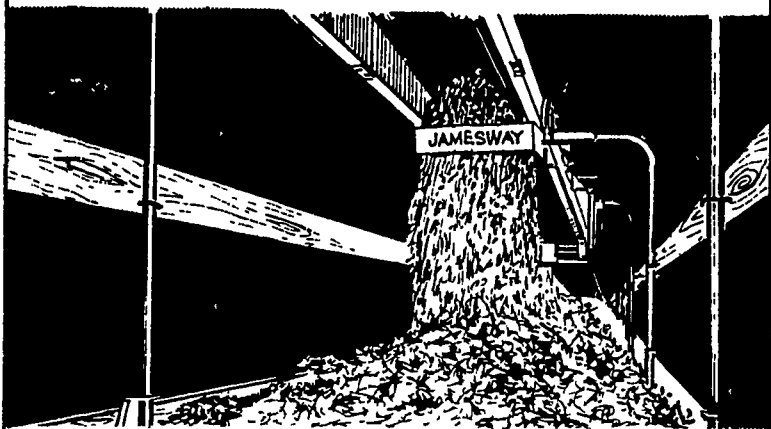
New Jersey at a cut-rate store for 95c a gallon when they could have bought the same or better milk in

We further ask why does the governor advocate going out of state to buy milk when the Commonwealth prohibits residents going out of state to purchase quantities of liquor and cigarettes a lot cheaper than our state can sell these commodities to our citizens.

The Pennsylvania State Grange strongly endorses the Milk Marketing Board and urges its continuance as a separate function of government not related to any other department of the Commonwealth.

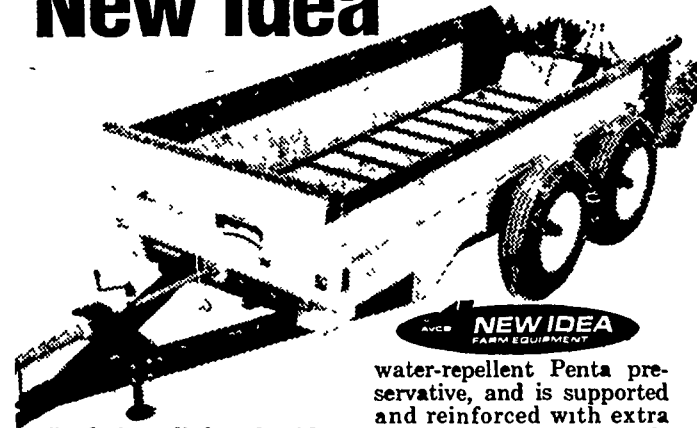
