Pollution problems associated with the soil and its water content. occur mainly because we have no socially or economically acceptable ways to correct the situation, Dr. Milford R. Heddleson, professor of agronomy extension at Pennsylvania State University, points out.

dleson said "fortunately nature provided built-in mechanisms that enable the soil to dispose of unwanted materials but we must devote time and direct resources in improving this efficiency."

Both bacteria and fungi that are present in the soil surface area rapidly break down organic wastes in an aerobic environment, the Penn State specialist emphasized. This is both a normal soil building and a waste destruction process being carried on simultaneously.

"Since soils are pretty much self-rejuvenated with time, it would seem most practical to speed up studies in this area," he said. "If we are going to accommodate the growing volume of wastes, we must devise ways of using the soil as an efficient disposal medium which will reduce water pollution hazards as well."


