23,842 pounds of milk and 926 pounds of fat.

King placed first in the high herd contest with 16,453 pounds of milk and 618 pounds of butterfat, and Umble came in second with 15,106 pounds of milk and 606 pounds of fat.

Six men were recognized for their yields in the corn silage contest. The men and their yields are:

Paul King, 14,817.6 pounds total digestible nutrients (TDN) per acre, first; Ivan Horst, Christiana RD1, 14,398.2 TDN, second; Vernon Umble, 11,340.0 TDN, third; Larry Hershey, Atglen, 10,518.0 TDN; Gideon Stoltzfus, Atglen, 9,952.0 TDN, and Landis Reid, Atglen, 9,817.6 TDN.

In the corn grain contest, the following men and their yields were cited:

Nathan King, Oxford RD1, 181.75 bushels per acre, first; Carl Horst, Atglen, 165.77 bushels, second; Art Hershey, Cochranville, 154.49 bushels, third; Jacob Herr, Atglen, 153.97 bushels; Merle King, Atglen, 153.35 bushels, and Paul King, 142.84 bushels.

In haylage recognition, Harry Greist, Parkesburg, was first place winner.

Three men were cited for their production in the hay contest. They are: Larry Hershey, first; Paul King, second, and Elmer Mast, Atglen, third.

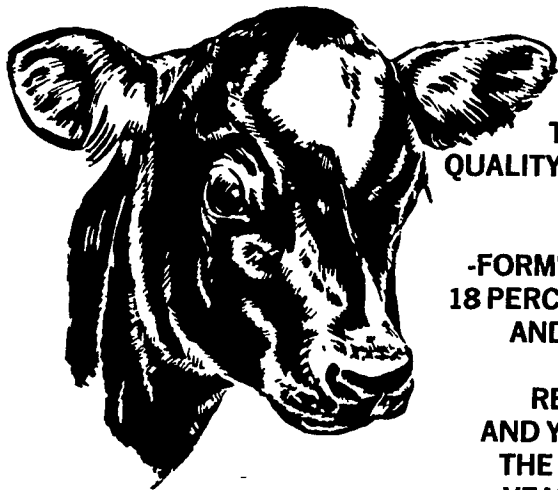
