

American-International Junior Charolais Leadership Conference

The third annual American-International Junior Charolais Foundation Leadership Conference will be held June 18 to 21 at Texas A & M University in College Station, Texas. Reservations have been made for 200

junior Charolais breeders to attend

Reservation request forms were mailed to each of AICA's 3,000 members in early April, Jim Olsen, AICA youth director, said. Applications will be ac-

cepted on a first-come, first-served basis, with older applicants receiving priority if more than 200 requests are received.

Junior members, or their sponsoring state or regional association, will be responsible for transportation to and from the conference with AICA assuming lodging and meal expenses

The conference attracts junior members between ages 14 and 21 from throughout the nation, and will be conducted in cooperation with the Texas A & M staff. In its first two years, the conference was held at Pennsylvania State University and Kansas State University respectively.

The AICA junior committee, in conjunction with the A & M staff, will present lectures, slide presentations and panel discussions on such topics as animal reproduction, genetics, nutrition, live steer and beef carcass evaluation and breeding efficiency. Other activities will include a tour of the University veterinary hospital and a leadership conference.

Recreational activities will include softball, football, swimming, volleyball, a catered barbecue, and a dance.

In the Kitchen

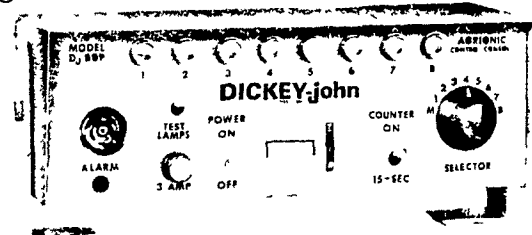
TAFELSPITZ UND APPELKRENN

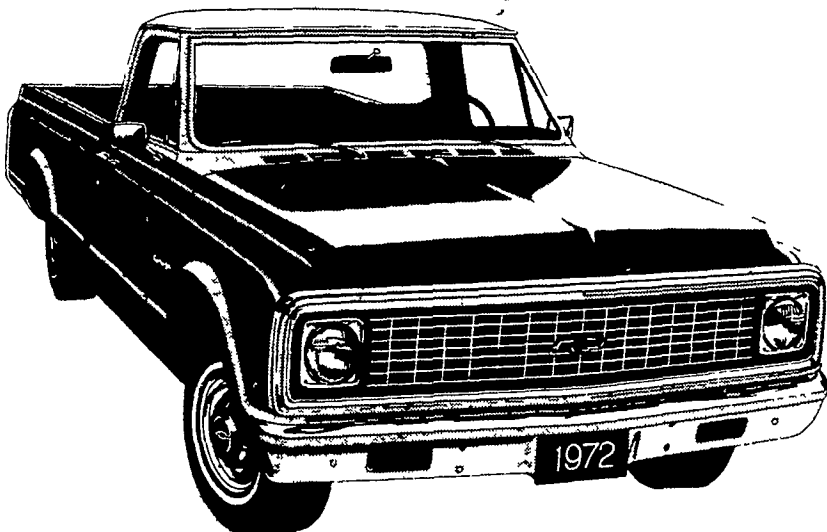
