

Pennfield Corporation Announces Grand Champion Challenge Trophy

Pennfield Corporation will sponsor a new Challenge Trophy at the 1972 Horse Show, announced Robert Graybill, Pennfield president. The trophy will be presented at the Horse Show at the Lancaster County Riding and Tennis Club on May 19, 20 and 21

on the Club's grounds at 2615 Columbia Avenue, Route 462 West, Lancaster.

The new Pennfield Grand Champion Challenge Trophy will be offered for Class 226, which is the Pony Hunter grand champion cup. This is an award presented

to the overall winner in the class accumulating the greatest number of points in the Pony Working Hunter sections. The Pennfield Challenge Trophy must be won three times before it can become the permanent property of the winner.

This year's 39th annual Horse

Show, which will feature horses and riders from six states, will benefit the "dollars for Scholars" citizens' scholarship foundation which provides funds for students who have proven ability in their educational pursuits but who are in need of financial aid.

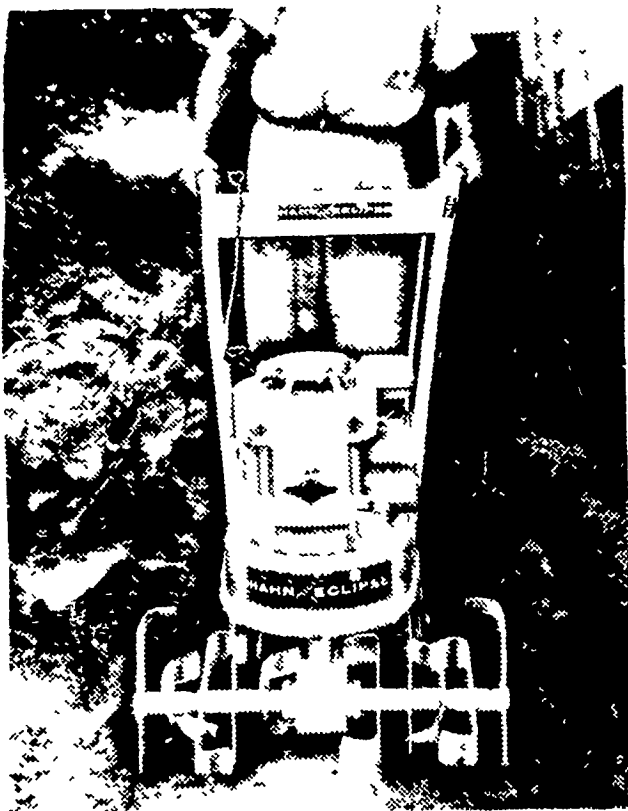
