



April Milk Production, **Use Reported by State**

April milk production was equal to March in both total and per cow figures according to the Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service, a joint venture of the Pennsylvania and U.S. Departments of Agriculture.

The state herd of 695,000 cows produced 626,000,000 pounds of milk during April for a per cow average of 900 pounds. The total is two per cent more than April, 1971, and the average is three per cent more as the number of milk cows was reduced by 9,000 in the past 12 months.

Total U.S. milk production for April at 10,655,000,000 pounds was up to two per cent from April a year ago. Total utilization of the milk in all forms - liquid, ice cream, food preparation, etc. -would result in a per capita daily consumption of 1.7 pounds, slightly more than 11/2 pints.

Pennsylvania is the fifth leading state in milk production with cash receipts from dairy products representing 43 per cent of the billion dollar farm economy in the Keystone State.
