Preliminary Report on Licensed Dairy Imports


USDA issued a preliminary report on imports of cheese and other dairy products against under import licenses regulations. Import quotas and licensing requirements are in force on certain dairy products to prevent material interference with the dairy price support program.

Among the cheese quotas, those on Cheddar, American-type other than Cheddar, Blue-mold, and natural Edam and Gouda cheeses were largely utilized. The Italian-type quotas showed a short-fall of about 40 per cent.

Imports under license of the socalled "pricebreak" cheeses were down; a considerable amount of low-fat cheese was shipped late in 1971, but because of dock strikes, came in early in 1972, the quotas on chocolate crumb were only about twothirds filled; and the 6,000 pound quota on malted milk and the 500 pound quota on dried cream were not used.




