Mediums adequate for regular customers with some outside inquiry unfilled Carton demand fairly good for spotty retail ads, fair otherwise. Undertone barely steady on large.

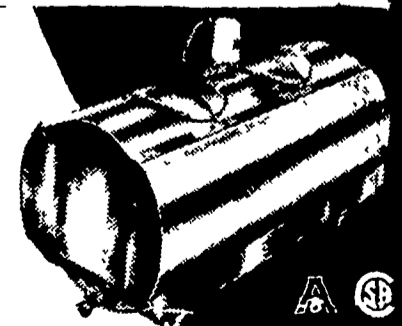

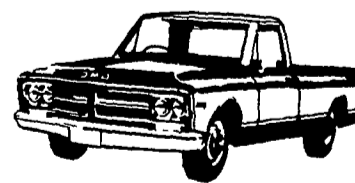
