USDA Releases Annual Milk Order Statistics

The U.S. Department of Agriculture has issued its annual compilation of "Federal Milk Order Market Statistics."

The new bulletin summarizes data published in monthly reports during 1971 on quantities of milk prices, prices and uses made of milk, including sales of fluid milk products. It also includes information on the number of handlers, marketing area population and gross values of milk.

The inside of a closet door is a good resting place for the ironing board. Put two screw-type clothes hooks near the bottom of the door to form a rack to hold the bottom of the folded board. About three feet above this, tack a lady's belt to the door and fasten it around the upper part of the board to hold it in place. Put the flat part of the board against the door and the board stays in place securely.

If you cannot find gravel for the top of your window box, put grass clippings over the top. This will save your windows from dirt spatters when you water the flowers.

Dig the grass into the dirt the following year for organic fertilizer.

Before you walk through your garden, fasten a paper bag with a snap clothespin to your belt or apron. Drop wilted flowers, dead leaves, etc., into the bag and keep your garden neater with less effort.

This covers and seals the hole and, being clear, is scarcely noticeable

WHEN PURCHASING ventilation fans for confinement livestock buildings, producers should look for the following:

- Fan blades and housing of corrosion-resistant material.

— A totally-enclosed electric motor that does not overheat when covered with dust.

- Sealed bearings that eliminate periodic oiling.

- Circuit overload protection that shuts off the electric current if the motor is plugged up with ice or dirt.

 Automatic shutters which close when the fan stops running.
 Hood over outside of the fan

to keep direct wind blasts, snow and water from getting into the fan.

— Wire-mesh type or other guard over the fan intake to avoid injuries and to keep out birds.
