

Often one hears about using the public schools 12 months a year — officially, that is. Well, it isn't until you've used the schools in the Summer that you realize how many other people are doing the same thing.



The Lefevre house is furnished with great chests brought with them from France and primitive tables from their earliest days. Boys managed to catch wild geese and then kept them with the domestic ones in this manner until they became tame. This was to improve their breeding stock.
