

Foremans named to Attend Iowa Co-op Institute

Mr. and Mrs. Jay R. Foreman of RD1, Lititz, have been selected by Agway Inc. to attend the 1972 National Institute on Cooperative Education, July 30 to August 3, at Iowa State University.

The Foremans are one of six

young farm couples in Agway territory chosen to participate in the institute which brings together young farm leaders and leaders in agriculture, education, government, industry, civic organizations and cooperatives.

The six couples will be accompanied by Mr. and Mrs. Paul Grubb of Syracuse. Mr. Grubb is Agway's director of member relations.

The American Institute of Cooperation, supported by 3,000 farmer cooperatives, is the educational organization serving farmer cooperatives.

The Foremans, who are Agway members, farm 136 acres of corn, alfalfa, tobacco, wheat and barley and maintain an 80-head herd of registered dairy cows. They have four children and are active in farm groups, including the Young Farmer Association, ASCS, and the Lehigh Valley Cooperative Advisory Council.

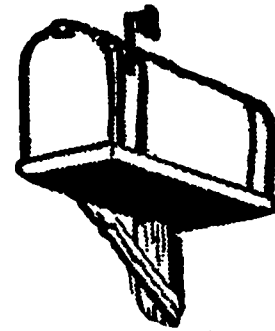

in terms of quarters and dollar bills, of gifts that multiply, such as heifers and pigs and chicks, or people who are not statistical units but have ticking hearts.

"In a world grown almost unbearably complicated, they go about their enterprise with a serene simplicity providing help here and there in small quantities to the limit of their capability. They have been doing it for a quarter century.

"Alongside the needs of the overpopulated and undernourished parts of the world, this effort must seem pathetically feeble. It concerns mere persons, families and villages — not mass populations. But then again, there doesn't have to be a vast bureaucracy and there is little if any waste."

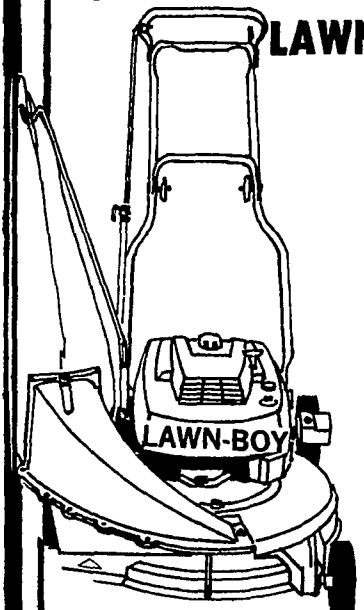

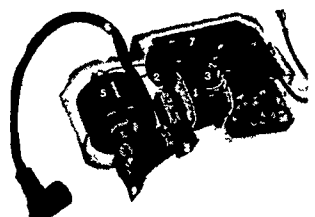

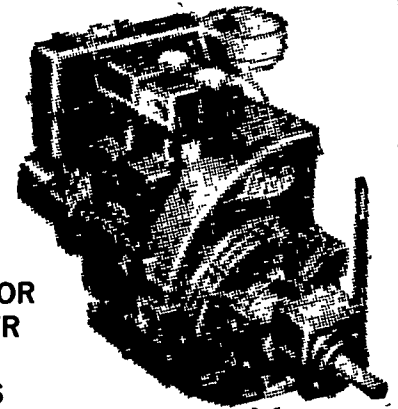
