His entry, a daughter of Fernhame Ivanhoe Emperor who has a Kingpin son slated to enter service at SIRE POWER, sold to Dale Ring of Wooster, Ohio

Included in the sale were an outstanding group of Whirlhill Kingpin daughters A pair of them, the consignments of Melvin Peifer, Canton, Pa. and Richard Landis, Lancaster, Pa brought \$1825.
