

## Chester County 4-H'ers Win At Regional 4-H Sheep Show

Several Chester County 4-H members won honors at the first annual Southeast Pennsylvania 4-H Sheep Show held recently at the Montgomery County 4-H Center, Lansdale.

Steven VanVleet, Pottstown, was named the best senior showman while exhibiting the champion Hampshire sheep, later named the champion of the show Ann Baroni, Downingtown, placed first in the junior division blocking contest and second in junior division showmanship contest.

Karen Blumenthal, Chester Springs, placed first in the first year member showmanship contest while her brother Robert, placed second. Joan Liesau, Spring City, placed first in the senior division of the blocking contest and second in senior division showmanship, while exhibiting the reserve champion Hampshire sheep.

In the Hampshire breed competition, Joan Liesau

exhibited the first place aged ewe and ewe lamb, and the second place yearling, while Steven VanVleet exhibited the first place yearling and Robert Blumenthal sixth place ewe lamb.

In the Dorset ewe lamb competition, Karen Blumenthal exhibited second place animal while Ray Taylor, Elverson, showed the third place Suffolk ewe lamb.

In the junior showmanship contest, Jeff Baroni, Downingtown placed seventh. Ray Taylor placed third in the junior blocking contest while Steven VanVleet placed fifth in the senior blocking contest.

There were 39 different animals shown with 45 different 4-H members participating in the show. The regional 4-H Sheep Show is one segment of the 4-H sheep project sponsored by the Chester County Cooperative Extension Service and The Pennsylvania State University. Members in the sheep project

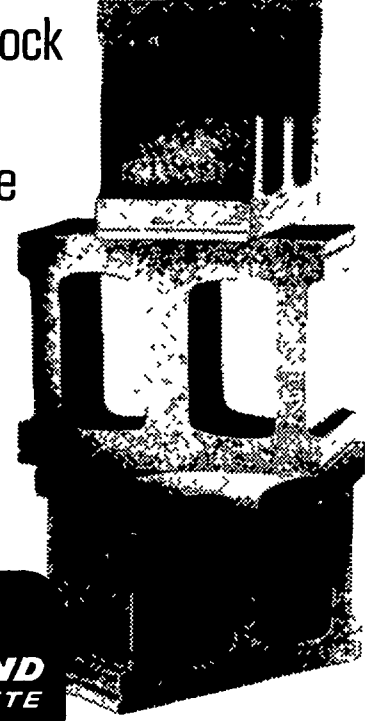

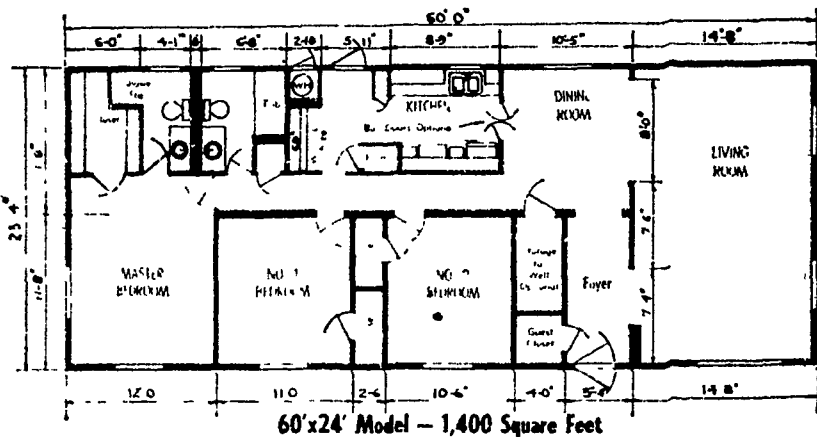
