In the Hampshire breed competition, Joan Liesau exhibited the first place aged ewe and ewe lamb, and the second place yearling, while Steven VanVleet exhibited the first place yearling and Robert Blumenthal sixth place ewe lamb.

In the Dorset ewe lamb competition, Karen Blumenthal exhibited second place animal while Ray Taylor, Elverson, showed the third place Suffolk ewe lamb.

In the junior showmanship Jeff contest, Baroni, Downingtown placed seventh. Ray Taylor placed third in the junior blocking contest while Steven VanVleet placed fifth in the senior blocking contest.

Grey, who is fifty, is married to the former Emily Kelly. The Grevs have three sons and a daughter, and reside in York.






