

All-American Grants Status To Railbirds

"Railbird judging" was officially recognized for the first time at the Ninth Annual Pennsylvania All-American Dairy Show this week in Harrisburg. Railbirds exist in all spectator sports but are known by different

names. In football, they're called Monday morning quarterbacks and in baseball they're named grandstand managers. They are the second-guessers, kibitzers. Although dairy show managers select only the top in-

ternationally-acclaimed judges, there always exists that group of breeders and herdsmen that think they are better. This is, at best, an immodest attitude as the judges for this year's All-American came from all parts of North America — two from Wisconsin and one each from California, Tennessee, Ohio and Canada.

Twice each day, during the judging in the main arena, the judges initially selected six of the top cows in a class. Other officials distributed scorecards to interested railbirds who had an opportunity to place six animals in their proper order.

The cards were then collected and within an hour or so, aided by computerized grading, a winner was announced. The winner in each class received a trophy.

American Meat Institute Annual Meeting Oct. 1-3

Commission, Dr. Philip L. White, Secretary Council on Foods and Nutrition, American Medical Association and top meat industry spokesmen. Consumer interests and food retailing also will come under scrutiny. The industry representatives will hear in-depth discussion of how best they may serve consumers. The American Meat Institute is the national trade, research and educational association of the meat packing and processing industry.

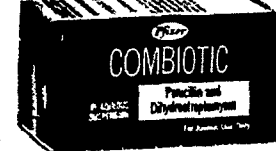
