





When any hard finish floor coatings wear out, it is generally necessary to refinish the entire floor rather than small areas.

Shellac goes on easily, dries quickly so additional coats can be added soon. It is tough, does not darken and wears well but spilled standing water will turn the surface white.

Varnish is just as tough and is more resistant to water staining. It takes much longer to dry and tends to darken with age.

The new synthetic lacquers and plastic coatings are light in color, thinner and quick to dry. More coats are needed but applications are easier.
