Cherry Rolls

1 egg
3/4 cup sour cream
2 cups flour
1/4 teaspoon Soda
2 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
3/4 teaspoon salt
2 tablespoons sugar
2 cups drained cherries
2 tablespoons butter
1 teaspoon cinnamon

Beat egg and add sour cream. Sift flour; measure and add salt, soda and baking powder. Sift again. Add sifted dry ingredients and stir until well mixed. Toss onto a slightly floured board and roll in an oblong piece 1/4-inch thick.

Spread lightly with soft butter and cover with cherries. Sprinkle cherries with cinnamon and suger.

Roll up like a jelly rool and cut in crosswise slices, 1/4 inches thick. Place slices close together, cut side turned up in a greased baking pan.

Pour over them the following sauce:

1-3 cup brown sugar
1-3 cup white sugar
1 1/2 tablespoons cornstarch
1 1/2 tablespoons butter
1 1/2 cups cherry juice
Few drops red coloring
1/2 teaspoons almond extract
Combine dry ingredients, add

liquid, coloring and flavoring. Bring to a boil. When slightly thickened, add butter and pour over rolls. Bake at 375 degrees for 25 minutes. Makes 12 rolls. Serve warm with milk.
