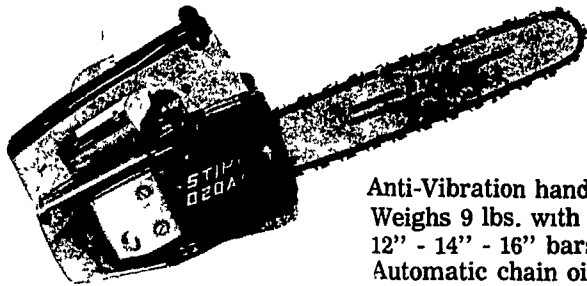

Scratches on Non-Stick Finishes

Scratches may affect the appearance of non-stick utensils, but they make little or no difference in the performance of the utensil. Extension home management specialists at Pennsylvania State University explain that since non-stick finishes are so flexible, scratches don't open into wide gaps or cause chipping or peeling. Despite scratches, pans with a non-stick finish are still easy to clean and give good service.
