# **Ice Follies at Hershey Next Week**

Ice Follies "Spectrum '73," featuring Miss Trixie Schuba, recent Gold Medal winner at the 1972 Winter Olympic Games in Sapparo, Japan, is coming to Hersheypark Arena for a six-day engagement from Nov. 28 to Dec.

The traditional family show, offering its own special appeal for everyone, will play nine shows in the Arena with performances scheduled for Tuesday through Friday at 8:10 p.m.; Saturday at 1, 5 and 9 p.m.; and Sunday at 2 and 6 p.m.

The production numbers will again feature the Ice Folliettes. plus all the stars, with elaborate staging, costuming and lighting effects. Also, according to all reviews of the show, the best '73 musical score offers the best in



contemporary sound originality.

For sheer laughter, the ageless Mr. Frick will be on hand, joined by the Scarecrows, Funsters and Kevin Bupp. Another newcomer, David Comb, introduces his acrobatic skating routine that is unparalleled in skating circles.


