Four area 4-H'ers have won scholarships for their achievements, it was announced this week in Chicago during the 51st National 4-H Congress. They are: Agnes Arnold, Lebanon; Walter Latshaw, Spring City; Sarah Schroeder, Kempton, and Ann Stratton, Kutztown.

Agnes Arnold was one of six national winners in the 4-H food-nutrition program. Her \$700 scholarship will be paid for by General Foods Corporation, who also paid her expenses to the Congress. Miss Arnold is the daughter of Mrs. Mary M. Arnold, and a sophomore at Penn State. She won the scholarship for teaching good nutrition to children from low-income families.

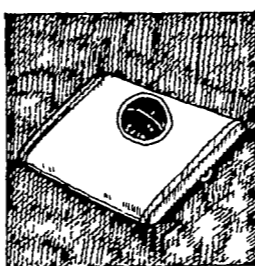
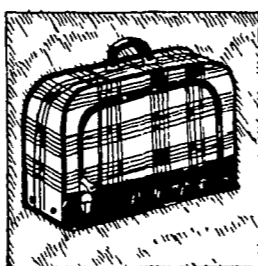
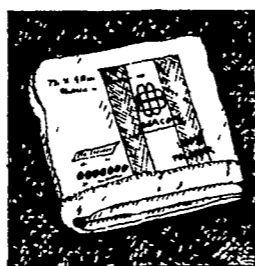
