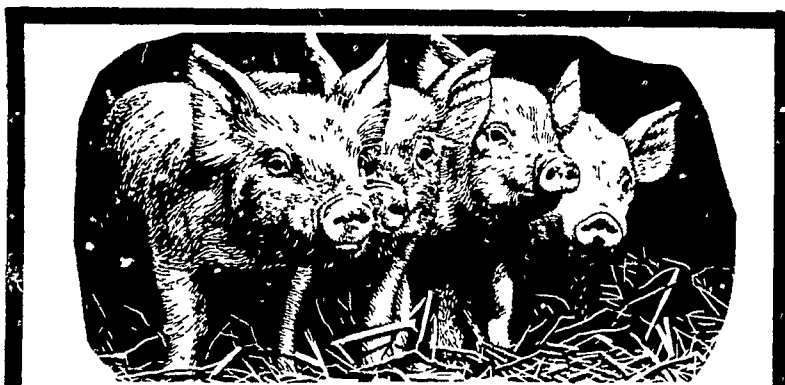
Pomona Master, Jesse Wood, announced a Pomona officers meeting to be held at his home January 2 at 8 p m.

Broiler Placements Down

Placement of broiler chicks in the Commonwealth during the week ending December 2 were 1,094,000. The placements were 13 per cent below the corresponding week a year earlier, and two per

cent below the previous week. Average placements during the past 10 weeks were eight per cent below a year earlier.

Settings for broiler chicks were 1,842,000 — five per cent above the previous week and three per cent above the comparable period a year ago.

The shipments of broiler-type chicks during the past 10 weeks averaged 25,000 compared with 15,000 a year ago. Outshipments were 71,191,000, about the same as the previous week but two per cent above a year earlier.

The current three-week total of eggs set in one per cent below the comparable period a year ago.

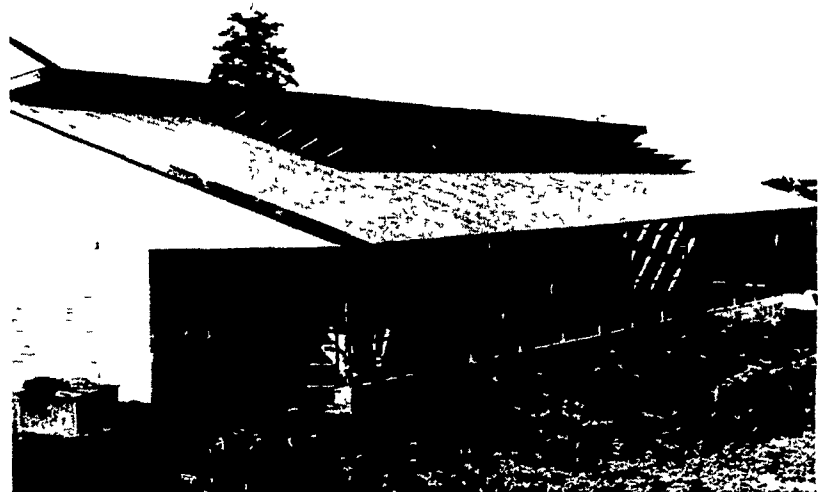

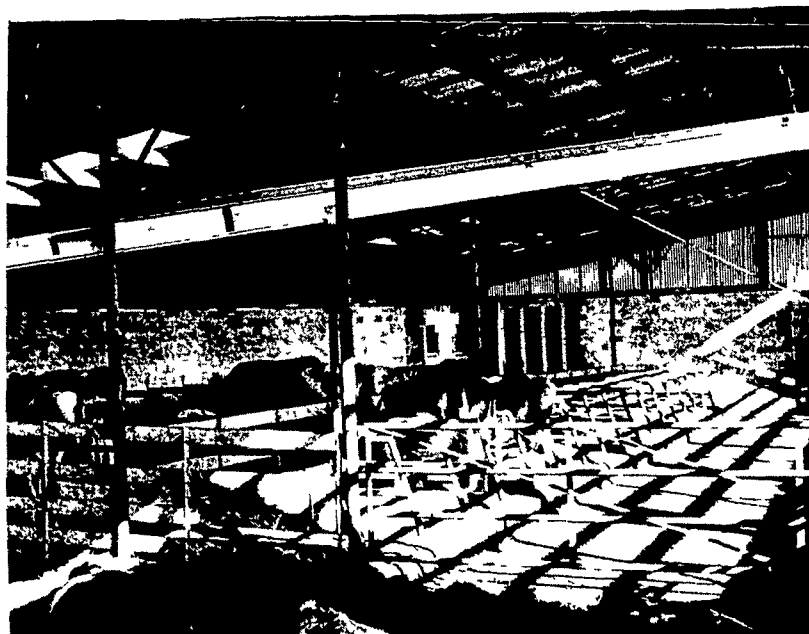

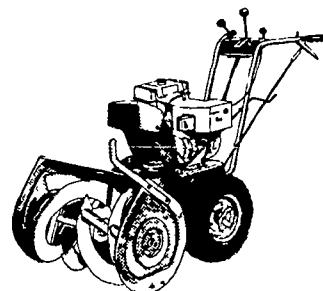
