### New Dishwasher has 40% Fewer Parts

A new undercounter dishwasher line with 40 percent fewer parts than previous models is being introduced by Westinghouse Electric Corporation's Major appliance group.

"This drastic reduction in parts has resulted in greater mechanical reliability than we have ever been able to offer," said Joseph L. McGowan, marketing manager, major appliance group.

"Our goal was to design, engineer and manufacture the most reliable and basic dishwasher possible, so consumers will have the same basic and constant built-in reliability and serviceability for the entire undercounter line."

Under development for more than four years, the undercounter dishwasher line includes an innovative drying system.

The 'Power Dry' forced-air system dries dishes at a lower temperature, making it safe for all dishwasher-approved dinnerware and plastics. When drying is done, the dishes are cool enough to be removed at once.



Warm air is forced over and around the dishes. The warm, moist air is drawn out of the dishwasher and mixed with the warm dry air from the motor to remove steam and humidity.

Other features included in the line are:

- A soft food waste disposer that eliminates the need for pre-rinsing.
- Less installation time than

- previous undercounter units;
- Extra sound insulation provides quieter operation,
- Exclusive dual safety system to prevent water overflow.

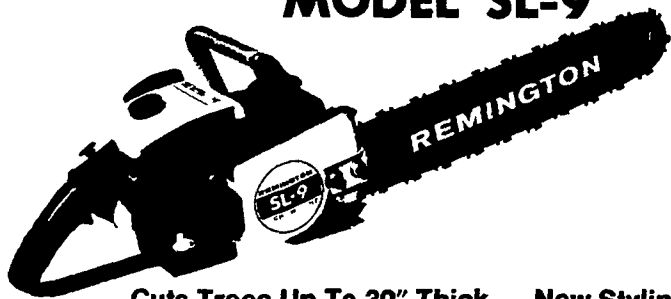

### Greater Sanitation Provided Using Automatic Dishwasher

An automatic dishwasher washes your dishes properly in water hotter than your hands could stand and with detergent stronger than you could use if doing dishes by hand. And the dishes are dried in a more sanitary way than towel dried.

June Wilke, Chester County Extension home economist, says that for best results with your automatic dishwasher you should set your hot water heater for a temperature of from 140 to 160 degrees. But keep in mind the farther the hot water has to travel to the dishwasher the cooler it will be when it washes your dishes. The setting on the hot water will depend on how far the water will have to travel to

reach the dishwasher.

Dishwashers actually use less water than that normally used to hand wash the same number of dishes. Miss Wilke explains that almost all dishwashers use a maximum of 12 to 15 gallons per cycle — that's two washes and three rinses.

Dishes washed in automatic dishwashers are more sanitary. Hot water, strong detergent, powerful spray and hot-air drying all contribute to the increased sanitation of washing dishes automatically. And if your family suffers from colds, you may cut down on the incidence of illness by using a more sanitary method of washing the family dishes.
