 calf for a period of 1 to 1.5 days. Preferably feed the electrolyte solution 3-4 times daily.
 For example: A 90 lb. calf might receive a quart of electrolyte solution four times daily. Make up the electrolyte solution fresh each day. If oral antibiotic medication is used, place it in the allowance of electrolyte solution at a level in accordance with directions on the label.
 Remember, there is NO substitute for good management.
