Full cooperation of those selected for the survey is urged because each farm has been selected to represent an important sector of the entire farm economy. Individual farm information is kept confidential and will be used only to develop regional and antional summaries of the reported averages and totals

An earlier study for weighting the statistical input needs to be modernized. An example is that farmers buy considerably more fuel, fertilizer and machinery but less labor than several years ago. However, the extent of this substitution of capital for labor is not adequately known.
