

The Merrimack, N H. facility of Anheuser-Busch, Inc. will be the home of a working team of Clydesdale draft horses.

August A Busch, Jr., chairman of the board and chief executive officer, in announcing expansion of the visitors hamlet at the Merrimack plant, said New England people and visitors have shown a high interest in the Merrimack brewery. Nearly 100,-000 persons have toured the facility already this year

The new complex will inclue a Clydesdale barn, tack room, can hage house and pasture for the 12 horses and eight oven The oven, long native to New England, will be a special added attraction

The display of Clydesdales and oven, all giant animals with many weighing a ton each brings together exceptional species from two continents

While both originated in Europe oven have been associated with American agriculture and the founding of Colonial towns in New England since the sixteen hundieds


