Raisin Delight

Batter:

- ¼ cup butter or margarine
- 1 cup sugar
- 2 cups flour
- 1 cup milk
- 4 teaspoons baking powder

Syrup

- 1 tablespoon butter or margarine
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 1½ cups raisins
- 4 cups boiling water
- 2 teaspoons vanilla

Combine syrup ingredients and boil five minutes

Prepare batter and pour into greased oblong pan. Pour hot syrup over batter spreading raisins evenly. Bake 30-35 minutes at 350 degrees. Serve with whipped cream or milk.

Sunshine Cake

- 1½ cups sifted cake flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 6 egg yolks
- 1½ cups sugar

- 1 teaspoon lemon extract
- 1 teaspoon grated lemon rind
- 1-3 cup cold water
- 6 egg whites
- ½ teaspoon cream of tartar

Sift flour, baking powder, and salt together. Set aside. Beat the egg yolks; beat in the sugar gradually. Continue beating until very thick. Then beat in lemon extract and rind.

Blend in dry ingredients alternately with water. Beat egg whites with cream of tartar until stiff. When peaks are formed, fold yolk mixture into whites. Bake in tube pan for one hour at 325 degrees

Filled Doughnuts

- 2 cups milk scalded and cooled
- ½ cup sugar
- 2 teaspoons salt
- 2 packs yeast
- 2 eggs
- ½ cup shortening
- 7 to 7½ cups flour

Soak yeast in one-half cup warm water. Put sugar, salt, beaten eggs and shortening to warm milk. Add yeast, then add flour. Knead till smooth and elastic. Let rise two hours.

Roll as cookies, making dough about ¼-inch thick. Cut with sharp knife. Let rise one hour. Fry in deep fat. Cut slit in side and fill with creamy filling.

Filling

- 2 egg whites
- 4 tablespoons milk
- 4 tablespoons flour
- 4 cups 10 X sugar

- ½ cup butter
- 1 teaspoon vanilla

Blueberry Filled Cookies

- 1½ cups brown sugar
- 1 cup shortening
- 2 eggs
- 1 cup quick cooking oatmeal
- 4 cups all purpose flour (scent)
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 teaspoon soda
- 2 teaspoons vanilla
- ¼ cup milk

Mix and let set overnight in warm place. Roll thin and cut large cookies. Add one teaspoon blueberry sauce. Cover with a smaller cookie.

Bake at low heat for 10 minutes.

Blueberry Sauce

1 quart blueberries plus one cup water and some sugar. Heat to boiling point and add one cup water mixed with one heaping tablespoon cornstarch.

One quart berries is enough for three batches of cookies or 100 cookies.

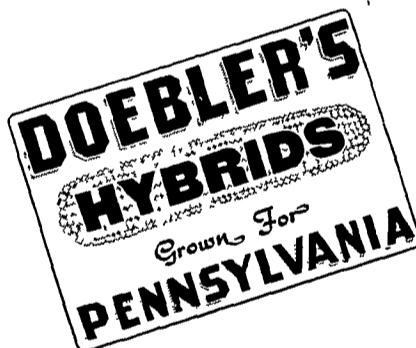
