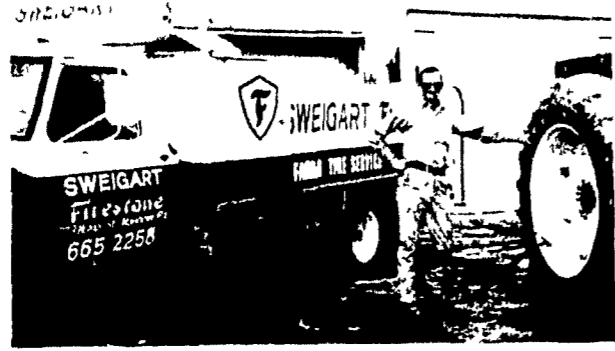

**Pa. Broiler
Placements
Rise 4 pct.**

Placements of broiler chicks in
the Commonwealth during the
week ending March 3, 1973 were
1,258,000 The placements were 4
percent above the corresponding
week a year earlier, and 5 per-
cent above the previous week
Average placements during the
past 10 week were 1 percent
above a year earlier.

Settings for broiler chicks were
2,136,000 - 4 percent above the
previous week and 7 percent
above the comparable period a
year earlier The current 3-week
total of eggs set is 6 percent
above the same period a year
ago

Inshipments of broiler-type
chicks during the past 10 weeks
averaged 5,000 compared with
7,000 a year ago

Outshipments averaged 237,000
during the past 10 weeks, 7
percent above a year earlier

Placements in the 22 States
were 59,442,000 - 5 percent above
the previous week but 6 percent
below the same week a year
earlier Average placements
during the past 10 weeks were 6
percent below a year ago

Settings were 76,322,000 - 1
percent above the previous week
but 4 percent below a year
earlier The current 3-week total
of eggs set is 4 percent below the
comparable period a year ago
