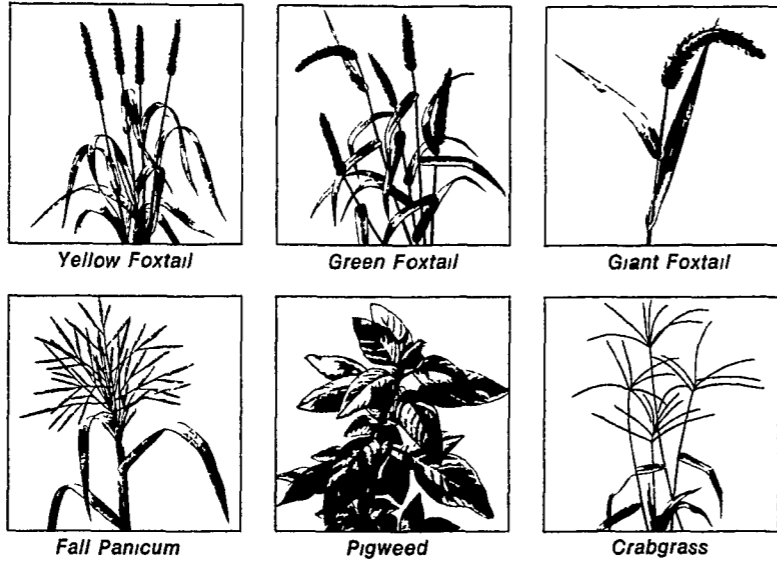


# Growers in Pennsylvania and the DelMarVa need weed control alternatives.



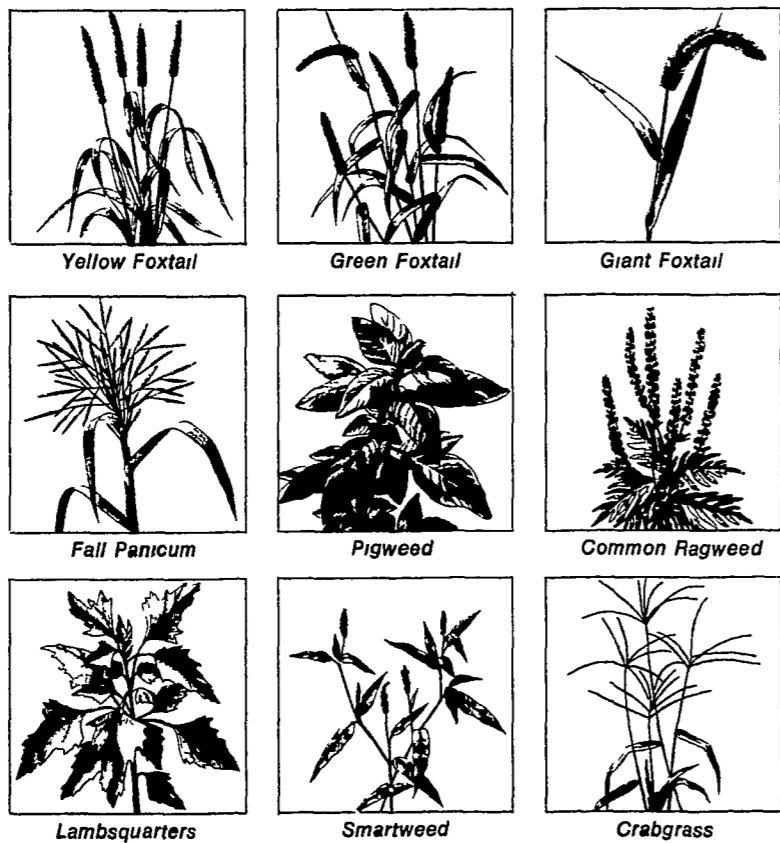
## In corn or soybeans if you've got:

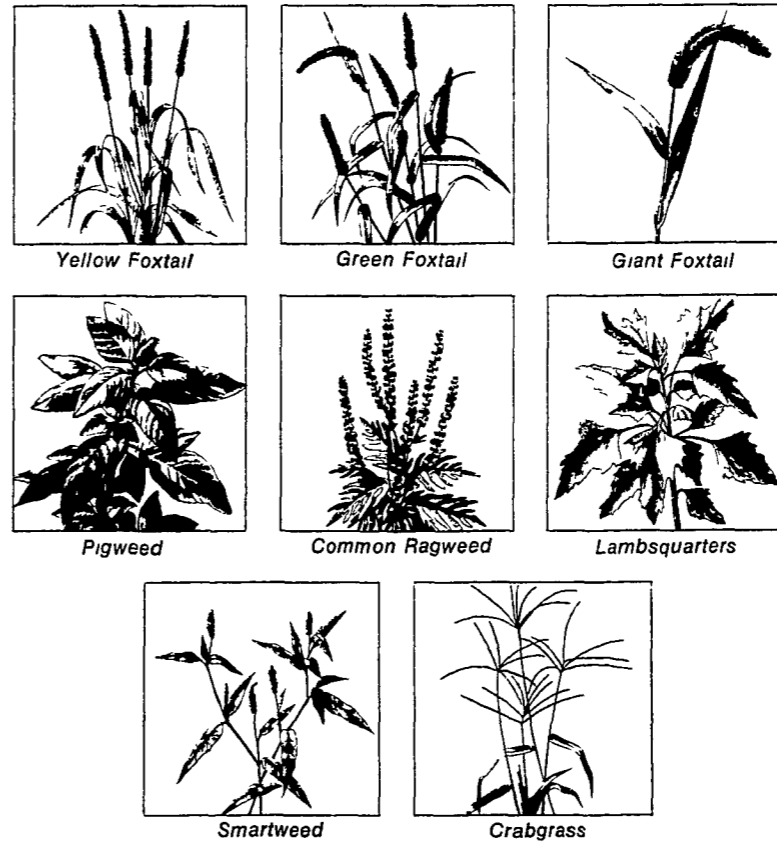
