1 pint cold milk
2 quarts milk
8 eggs, separated
3 cups sugar
1 teaspoon salt

6 teaspoons vanilla (or other flavors)
2 quarts light cream
Soak gelatine in pint of milk.
Beat egg yolks in another pint of

milk and add some of the sugar. Bring two quarts of milk and salt to a boil and add egg yolk mixture. Heat to boiling point, add gelatine, mix well and cool to 150 degrees. Add whipped cream, beaten egg whites with the rest of the sugar. Fills 6-quart freezer.

Potato Pancakes

2 eggs, separated
1 cup mashed potatoes
½ cup flour
1 cup milk
2 teaspoons baking powder.

Add egg yolks to the mashed potatoes and mix well. Add the flour and baking powder alternately with the milk until smooth. Fold in the stiffly beaten egg whites and drop spoonfuls on hot greased griddle or skillet. Finely chopped onion is sometimes sprinkled on the batter on griddle before turning.

Serve hot with meat.

Chocolate Marble Cake

2½ cups granulated sugar
¾ cup lard
Pinch salt
1½ cups cold water or milk
4½ cups sifted flour
4½ teaspoons baking powder
6 egg whites, beaten stiff

Chocolate Mixture

¾ cup cocoa
6 tablespoons sugar
¾ cup hot water

Mix together, cool before using. Then add ¾ teaspoons soda and 1½ teaspoons vanilla. Stir this in half of the batter.

Bake at 325 degrees for one hour. mix well and spread in bottom of pans.

Place cooked filling into two unbaked pie shells. Put crumbs on top and bake at 375 degrees till firm and brown. Makes two pies.

Potato Sticky Buns

2 cups cooked mashed potatoes
2 cups lukewarm water
2 cups sugar
1 tablespoon salt
1 cup melted shortening
2 packages yeast
4 cups flour

Mix these ingredients and let rise one hour.

Add:

5 beaten eggs
6 cups flour

Mix and knead, then let rise until double in size. Roll and add melted butter, sprinkle on brown sugar and cinnamon, then roll like a jelly roll and cut into ½ inch slices and put on top of syrup in pans. Let rise again one hour, then bake 30 minutes at 350 degrees.

Syrup

1-3 cup margarine or melted butter

½ cup brown sugar
1 tablespoon molasses

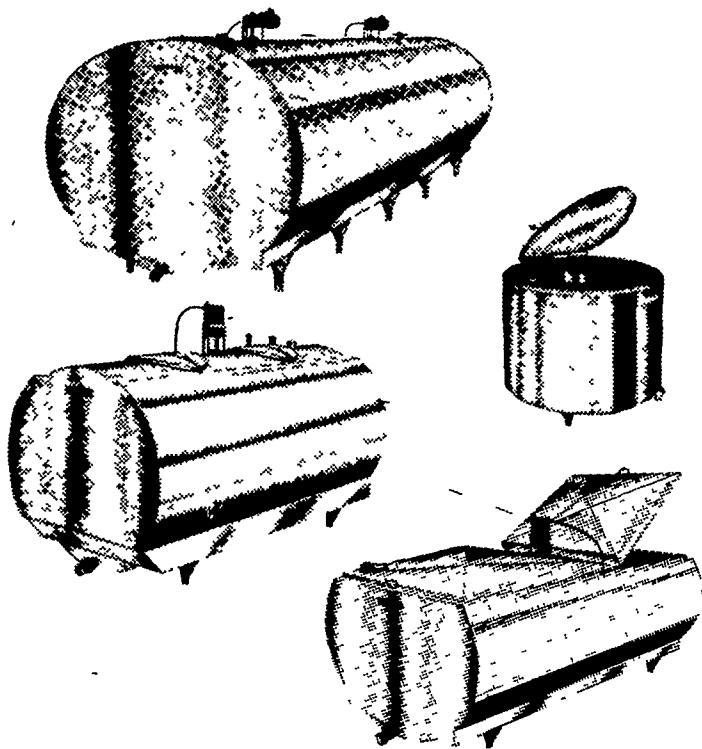

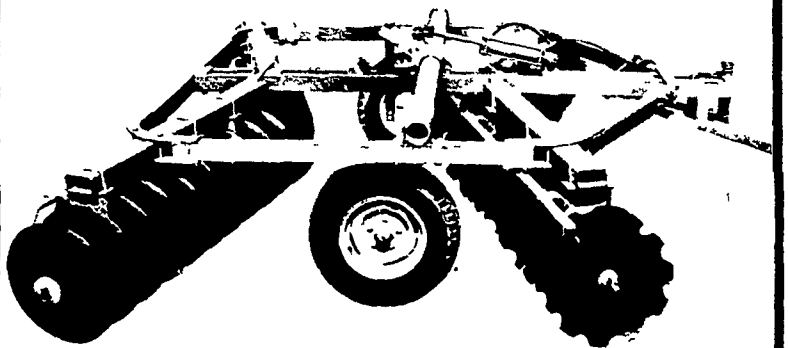
