The biggest obstacle facing the rehabilitated drug addict is finding a job. Gainful employment is one of the sine qua nons of the ex-addict's returning to a productive role in society. A year-long study by the New York State Temporary Commission to Evaluate the Drug Law disclosed discrimination exists in employment of rehabilitated addicts.

Some corporations, though, and their associations, have been making an effort to provide job training for those chronic drug users who have successfully completed detoxification and drug-free therapy. One such organization is the National Association of Engine and Boat Manufacturers, which has funded the New York City Addiction Service Agency's "Pioneer Marine School."

At the South Street Seaport Museum rehabilitated addicts undergo six months of intensive training in marine repair work aboard the USS William H. Hart. Upon graduation, they are virtually assured job placement in the critically undermanned field of marine repair.

The first twelve graduates of the program received their diplomas at the National Boat Show this Spring. They were able to choose from among 70 jobs, paying at least \$4 an hour.

In the words of A. W. MacKerer, chairman of the NAEEM Marine Service Council, "If we can fill a vital need of our own for service technicians, and at the same time do our part in alleviating some of the problems of today's youth—bringing them into an industry that we feel offers good opportunity and a wholesome way of life—our investment in this project will be repaid tenfold."
