Onion Supreme

Cook onions in salted water till tender and drain. Make a thick white sauce of one cup milk, one tablespoon butter, two tablespoons flour and add the onions. Remove from fire and fold in three well-beaten eggs and a teaspoon lemon juice.

Turn into buttered baking dish,

sprinkle with salt, pepper and paprika and bake till golden brown.

Grape Jelly

(For the freezer)

1 cup grapes
1 cup sugar
2 tablespoons water
Bring to a boil and let boil for 25 minutes. Put through ricer, put in jars, lids on loose. Put in freezer.

Oatmeal Bread

2 packages dry yeast
1 tablespoon salt
½ cup warm water
½ cups boiling water
1 cup oatmeal
½ cup molasses or honey
1-3 cup shortening
6 cups white flour or (4 cups whole wheat & 2 cups white flour)

2 eggs beaten
Soften yeast in warm water. Set aside. Combine boiling water, oatmeal, molasses or honey, shortening and salt. Cool to lukewarm. Stir in two cups flour and eggs. Beat well. Add yeast mixture. Beat well. Add enough remaining flour to make a soft dough. Cover lightly and refrigerate over-night. Shape into loaves, let rise until double in size. Bake at 375 degrees for 45 minutes

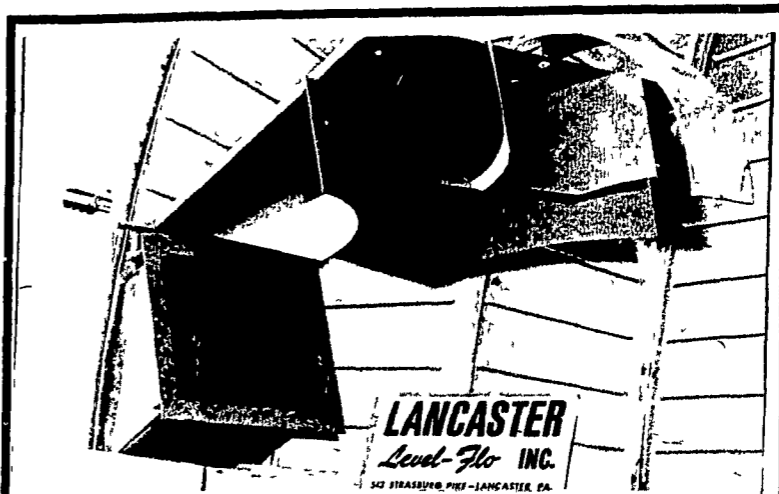
