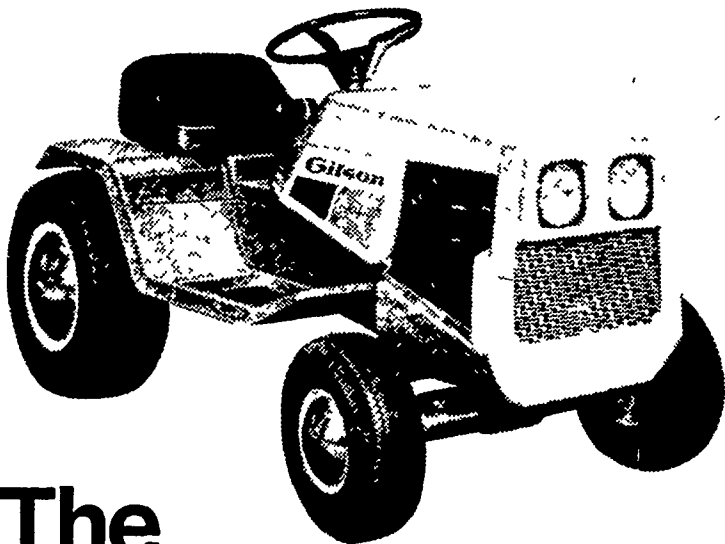

The family farm, like motherhood, is a durable institution.

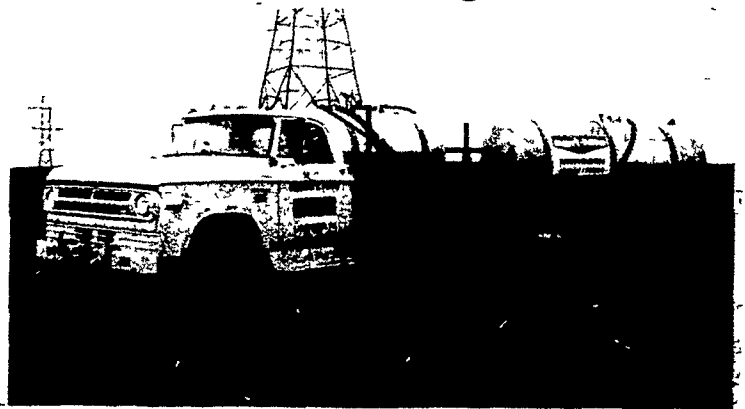

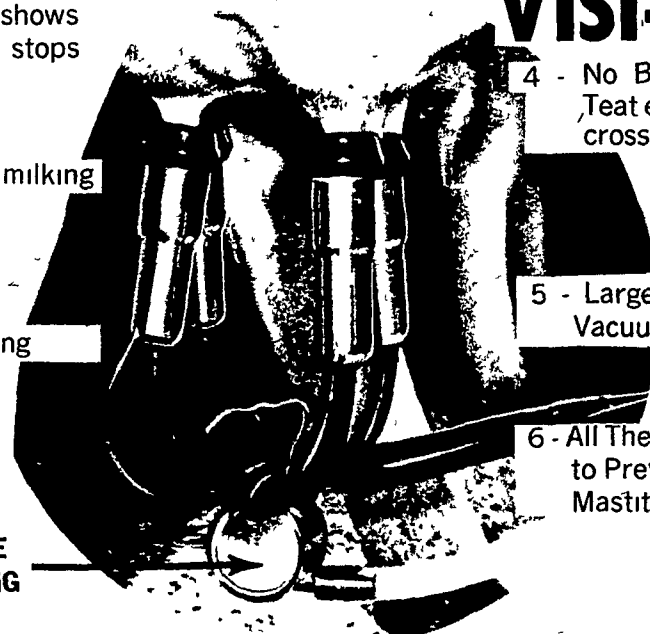
