Scientists Ponder Bees' Dislike Of Cotton Nectar


What do bees have against cotton blossoms?

That's what scientists at the University of Arizona are trying to find out

And the reason they want to know is a good one if bees would do the pollinating, hybrid cotton would be commercially feasible and might result in yield increases up to 25%

When confined in cages with cotton blossoms, the bees will almost starve before complying with attempts to get them to crosspollmate and aid in hybrid seed production

Already, it has been learned that bees swarm to some flowers and scorn others because of the presence or absence in the nectar of 13 basic sugars. Some sugars are actually toxic to bees, and these may exist in cotton nectar, scientists say

Q. I am the father of three boys, all of college age. My problem, aside from the big one of financing their education, is their health insurance protection. What I would like to know is how long my family policy will continue protecting my children?

A. Family health insurance protection for your youngsters may end when they reach age 19 or 21—although some companies will

extend coverage to age 23 and beyond, depending on situa-

You should also know that health insurance protection will end for your youngsters when they marry or enter the armed forces. Some policies continue coverage for unmarried, full time students depending on parental support (and the family-member provisions of your policy). If a child at 19 does move out of your coverage, many colleges provide student group health insurance plans included as an item in

college term billing.

Many modern policies, however, contain a conversion provision allowing your youngsters to obtain their own coverage when they ultimately become ineligible

for benefits under your policy. This is mandatory in New York


