Fund Donors**

The Lancaster County Humane League Building Fund Chairman, Irl Daffin, announced today that "approximately \$52,000 in contributions, allotments and pledges has been received to this date. Another \$45,000 must be raised", he continued, "to reach our Building Fund goal of \$97,000"

Clearing of the building site is presently underway with initial construction planned in the near future.

"Over 800 animals have passed through the Shelter in the first quarter of 1973," he said. "267 in the month of April alone. Presently facilities are totally inadequate to handle this steadily

increasing inflow of animals, hence our continued efforts to erect the new building with the greatest speed possible. To do this, of course," he emphasized, "we need the public's continuing help in making contributions to our Building Fund."
