Approved. She has three records over 13,000 lbs.

The Tornado bull did a good job at Conebella where he sired 25 registered females. The May 1969 USDA Sire Summary shows that 19 tested daus. av. 13389 M. 4.1 percent 557 F. and he has Plus Predicted Differences of 328 M. and 14 F. He is Approved and classified 86.5-VG.

Classification scores for the cows vary from 81.0 to 89.3. Six of the group are classified Very Good. It is interesting to note that the highest producer, Conebella Ruth, also has the highest type score, a high VG at 89.3.

Six of the group of cows have qualified for the rating of Approved Dam and are listed below:

In all, Conebella has bred or developed 31 Approved Dams. Ora Ruth's average on her daughters is among the highest recorded to date.

Researching the breeding and history of these Conebella cows one can only be impressed by the truly remarkable cow families that have been bred and developed here over the years.

The two dam-daughter pairs included in the group consists of Conebella Ruth and her daughter Conebella Ora Ruth, plus Conebella Mamie and her daughter Conebella Tor's Mamie.

Three of the cows are maternal sisters, daughters of Neddie's Heather Princess, a cow bred by Gables. She also became an Approved Dam at Conebella. Her lifetime production totals are 161,734 M and 6,200 F. She has a 4th daughter, Conebella Heather Princess, who made 151,321 M and 6,350 F lifetime, and is the dam of Conebella Priscilla, one of the 10 cow herd.

Conebella Ruth is by Wheel of Fortune and out of Conebella Dixie Queen, an 'Excellent' Approved Dam whose 3 daus. av. 15241 M. 4.1 percent and 623 F. Ruth has 3 milking daughters in the herd, a son born a year ago by Oracle that has just been sold, and 3 other sons (ful brothers) all by Betty. One of these is in service at Atlantic Breeders, one was used at Delchester Farms and one is in the Lyle Tabb herd in West Virginia.

Conebella Pat is by the 'Wheel' also and is out of Neddie's Heather Princess. Two daughters of Pat are in the milking herd, one went to South America and two younger heifers are at home. Conebella Mamie, by Preferred Kingfish and a

maternal sister to Pat, has a heifer and one milking daughter in the herd. A third was sold to the Keefers at Svcamore Mead Farm.

Conebella Tora Paula has three daughters in the herd, two milking, and one was sold to Harold Kulp at Pottstown. Tora Paula is by Tornado and out of Conebella Paula.

Conebella Lady Bird's three daughters include one milking at Conebella, one at the Keefers and one at Howard Fenstermaker's Lady Bird is by Reidma Double Don and out of Conebella Preferred Susie, 86.0-VG, an Approved Dam of 2 daus. that average 14249 M. 4.6 percent 654 F.

Conebella Tor's Janet, by Tornado and out of Neddie's Heather Princess has one heifer in the herd and a daughter at the Henderson Hevener's in Virginia.

Conebella Ora Ruth, by Oracle and out of Conebella Ruth, has one heifer and four milking daughters at Conebella.

Conebella Tor's Mamie, by Tornado and out of Conebella Mamie, has one daughter at the farm.

Conebella Royal Champion, sired by Glengarry Lloyd Royal and out of Conebella Champion 2nd, Approved, lifetime production of 151,062 M., and 6,915 F., has one daughter at home.

Conebella Priscilla has one daughter that went to George Page's Mar-Ral Farm in Illinois. Priscilla, by Tornado, is out of Conebella Heather Princess. 88.7-VG, whose lifetime production

was 151,321 pounds of milk and 6,350 of fat. The next dam made over 161,000

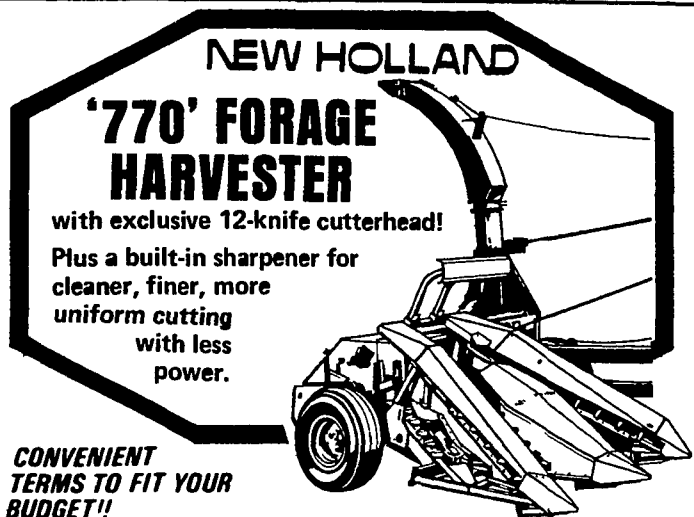
