shops held during the winter months over a two-year period, and totaling 30 days of instruction, discussion, and field trips," said Dr. Robert E. Howell, Penn State Extension rural sociologist and program director.

Seminars will be problemoriented and focus on topics in economics, sociology, government, and communications.

For those selected, a fellowship paid from the W.W. Kellogg Foundation grant and from contributions received from businesses, corporations, and individuals, will pay for costs of instruction, study materials, and most of the costs for room and board during the workships and field trips.

The workshops, held at a regional training center, will provide a subject matter background for assisting rural leaders with public decision making and community leadership, Dr. Howell added. Rural problems dealt with will include land-use planning, taxation, economic development, poverty, and farm income.

Instructors will be drawn from the Penn State faculty and selected for their specialized knowledge in the topics to be studied. In addition, recognized leaders from organizations, government, and industry will lead discussions on problems with which they have first-hand experience.
