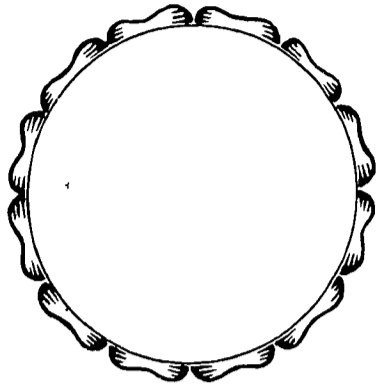
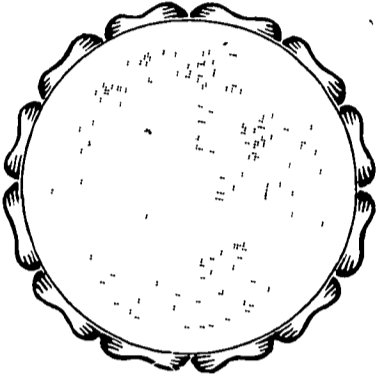

Leadership Studies Being Offered Rural Residents

UNIVERSITY PARK—Young men and women, who are concerned with rural community affairs and wish to explore possible solutions to public problems, may apply for enrollment in the fourth Public Affairs Leadership Program being offered by The Pennsylvania State University's College of Agriculture.

The program, open to farm and

nonfarm rural residents between the approximate ages of 25 and 40, is designed to improve the abilities of future leaders to make informed public decisions and to learn the process of group action.

To date, 264 rural Pennsylvanians have completed various phases of this unique educational program.

“Those taking part will attend a series of three four-day work-

shops held during the winter months over a two-year period, and totaling 30 days of instruction, discussion, and field trips,” said Dr. Robert E. Howell, Penn State Extension rural sociologist and program director.

Seminars will be problem-oriented and focus on topics in economics, sociology, government, and communications.

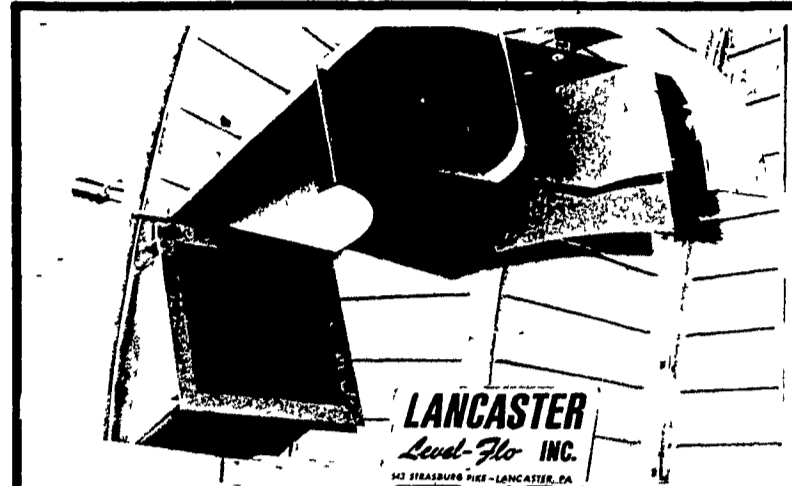
For those selected, a fellowship paid from the W.W. Kellogg Foundation grant and from contributions received from businesses, corporations, and individuals, will pay for costs of instruction, study materials, and most of the costs for room and board during the workshops and field trips.

The workshops, held at a regional training center, will provide a subject matter background for assisting rural leaders with public decision making and community leadership, Dr. Howell added. Rural problems dealt with will include land-use planning, taxation, economic development, poverty, and farm income.

Instructors will be drawn from the Penn State faculty and selected for their specialized knowledge in the topics to be studied. In addition, recognized leaders from organizations, government, and industry will lead discussions on problems with which they have first-hand experience.

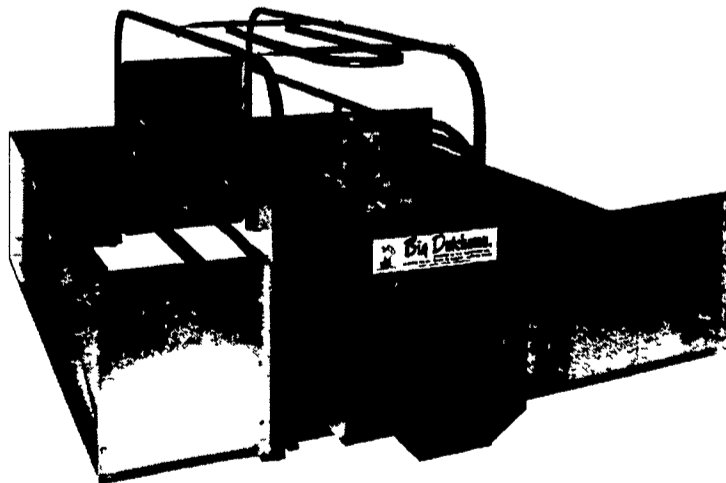
