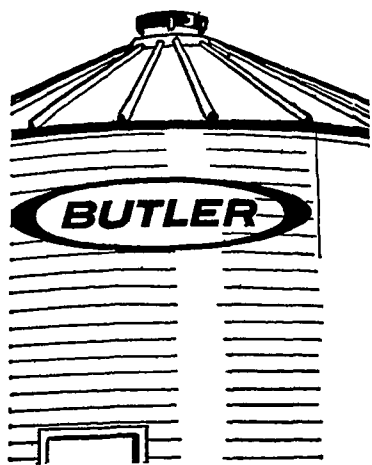
years.

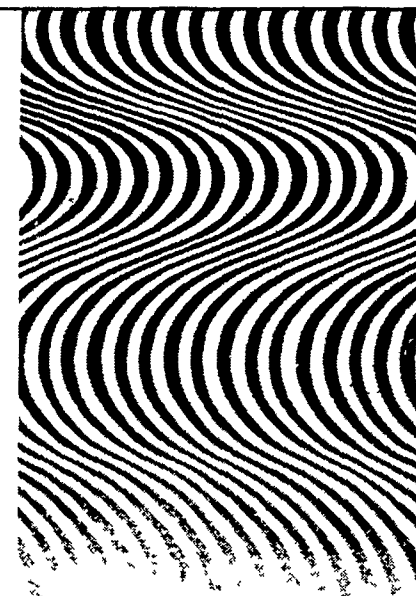
