A report from Penn State of weekly crop and weather roundups with a report on weather conditions for the week ending August 27.

In Lancaster, the average temperature for the week was 69 degrees, -2 degrees below the normal average for the time of year; weekly high was 87 degrees, low 53 degrees.

Growing degree days from April 1 for crops that start at 50degrees totaled 2415, or 34 more than normal in an average year. Rainfall for the week totaled
