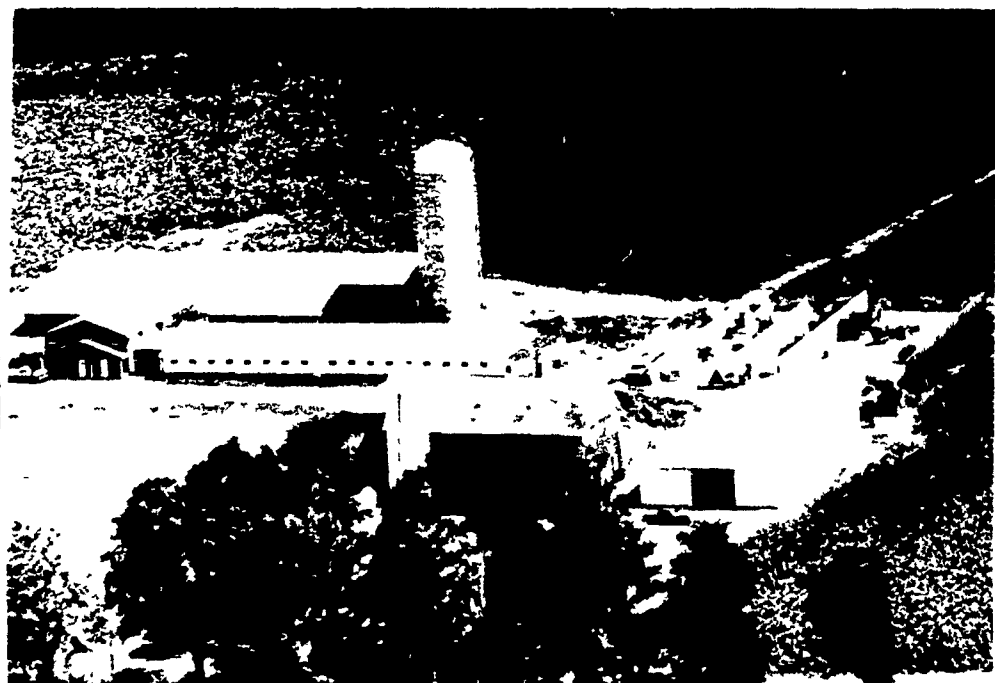

Eastern Dairy Farm

Fabius, New York



New facilities at the Dairy Research Farm, Fabius, New York, replace the farm which was located at Ellington, Connecticut, for nearly 30 years.

The dairy herd had been enlarged from 60 to 160 milking cows and is housed in the 60-stanchion dairy barn completed early in 1968, and a four-pen 100-cow free stall barn that went into use late in 1969.

Under construction is a four-unit herd replacement facility for 230 animals from birth to calving. The building is designed to investigate controlled environment in the baby calf nursing section, high animal density in the young stock and dry cows sections, and a newer system for handling animal waste, as well as nutritional studies with the animals involved.

There are 350 acres, of which 160 are devoted to crop production. A portion of the remaining acreage can be brought into production with soil drainage.

Staff at the Fabius farm has over 30 year's experience in research projects dealing with the use of urea, feeding methods, energy levels, once-a-day feeding of calves, varied rations, new ingredients, complete feeds for milking cows, extensive palatability studies, and numerous other projects.

As with all farms in the Cooperative Research network, technicians and researchers at Fabius keep in close touch and cooperate with the state agricultural and USDA scientists.
