They will also lead discussions concerning developing leadership ability with separate groups of Chapter officers.

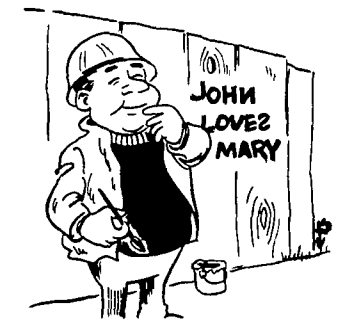
