

## 2 Lebanon Girls Get State 4-H Awards

Two Lebanon County 4-H members, who have compiled outstanding records in 4-H work, were named state contest winners in the 1973 4-H National Awards program.

They are Amy Schaffer, 16, Lebanon RD4, winner in horticulture, and Sharon Bom-

berger, 17, Lebanon RD2, state safety project winner.

Sharon will receive an expense-paid trip to National 4-H Congress in Chicago November 25-29. Amy will be eligible to attend the Chicago event. Both will compete for awards at the national level.

They were judged on the basis of project work, leadership ability, and participation in county and state 4-H activities.

The winners were picked from among the 215,000 4-H members who annually take part in the Extension Service youth education program.

## Bird Quarantines To Be Discussed

The U. S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has called a meeting of pet-bird importers, their associations, and other interested persons to be held 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, Oct. 9, in Washington, D. C.

Dr. Ernest E. Saulmon, deputy administrator of USDA's Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) said the meeting is in response to industry comments on proposed regulations requiring commercial bird importers to provide quarantine facilities before they may bring pet birds into the United States. (USDA press release 639-73).

APHIS import-export officials and USDA legal officers will meet with the interested persons to consider criteria for the construction and use of such bird quarantine facilities. They explained that quarantine facilities are necessary to prevent the introduction of exotic New castle disease and other contagious diseases of poultry.

A major consideration expressed in the industry comments was the lack of quarantine facilities to serve small importers, who cannot economically construct and maintain their own facilities. Birds must be kept isolated from domestic poultry and other birds for 30 days under conditions approved by USDA.

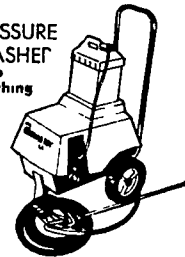

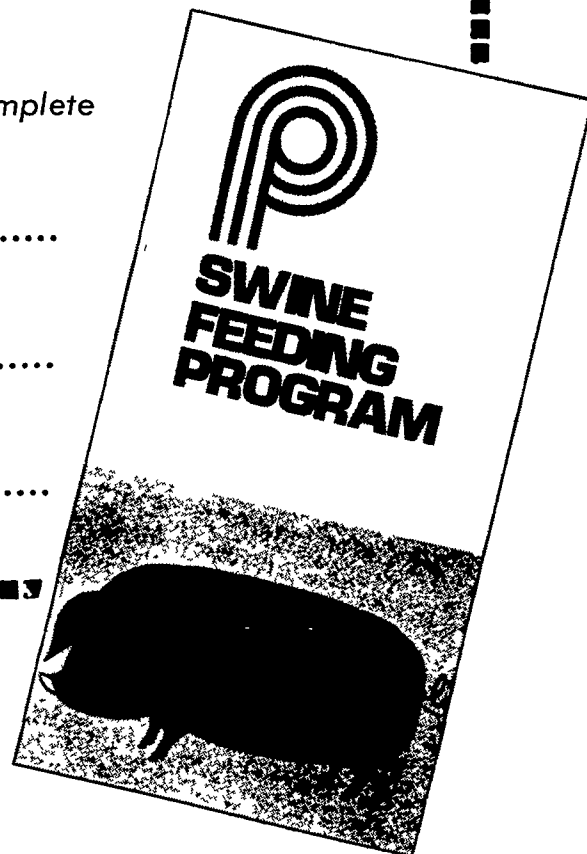
