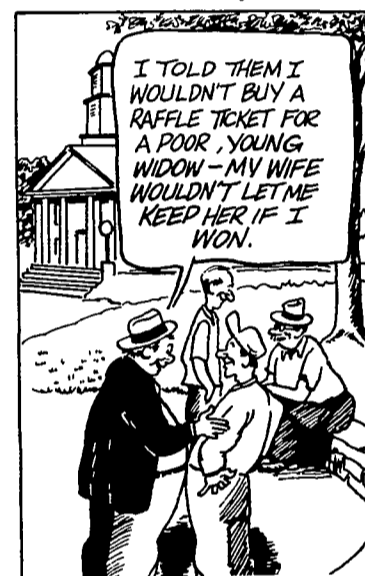
A \$50 donation was approved for the Welsh Mountain Clinic.

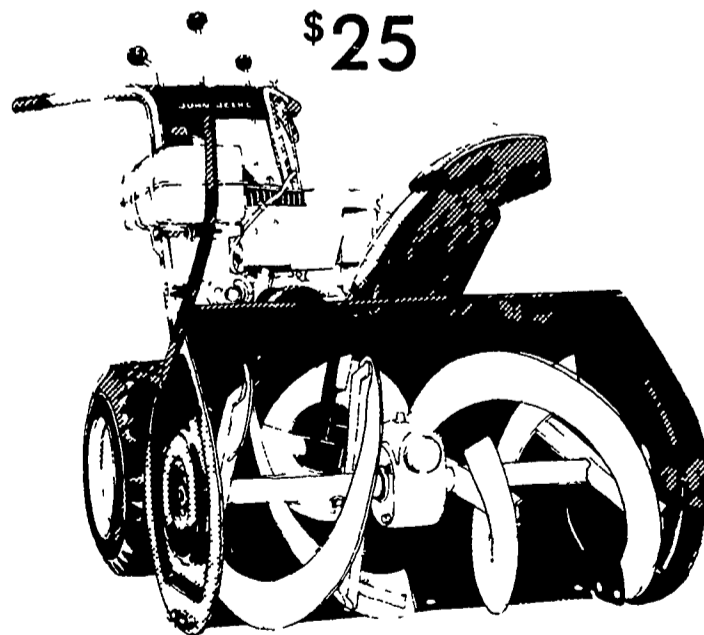
