"Everyone's a consumer," Says Jane Alexander

Jane Alexander, the York County attorney who is Pennsylvania's deputy secretary of agriculture, talked to the leaders about her job and her department at the conclusion of the awards ceremonies. She started by saying that the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture is the largest state ag department in the nation, and it serves the country's largest rural population. The imposing title of her often entertaining speech was "Consumer Attitude and Consumer Responsibilities in Today's Fluctuating Conditions".

"Candy and milk," Mrs. Alexander said, "are the two most emotional food products on the market. The milk industry does a good job of getting a wholesome product to the consumer, and most of the consumer complaints we get are the result of mishandling in the home.
