

Exciting Vegetables



Take a cue from vegetarians who make the most of vegetables and dress up your own. Sauce them, bread them, make them exciting so that everyone will join in the praises. Baked Eggplant: Mix 1/2 cup fine dry bread crumbs and ¼ cup grated Parmesan cheese. Slice 1 medium eggplant into ½ inch slices. Spread both sides of eggplant with ¼ cup real mayonnaise. Coat with crumb mixture. Bake in 425°F. oven, turning once, 15 minutes or until browned and tender. Serves 4 to 6.

Broccoli with Easy Hollandaise: In a saucepan gradually stir 1/3 cup milk into 3/4 cup real mayonnaise. Add dash of salt and pepper. Cook over low heat. Add 2 tablespoons lemon juice and a pinch of lemon rind. Serve over cooked and drained broccoli. Serves 4. Grilled Tomatoes: Cut three tomatoes in half crosswise. Sprinkle with salt and pepper. Stir together 1/3 cup real mayonnaise and 1 teaspoon grated onion; spread on cut sides of tomatoes. Broil about 5 inches from heat until golden brown, about 5 minutes. Serves 6.

Consumers' Corner

Food Labels May Change Next Year

Early next year you'll be seeing a new method of labeling nutrients in foods — the US RDA In the past, the MDR, or Minimum Daily Requirements, has

been used to indicate the minimum amounts of nutrients needed to prevent nutritional deficiencies.

The Federal Food and Drug

The Federal Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has approved the system for labeling food products, such as cereals, dietary supplements and foods with medicinal claims. The word "minimum," however, confused many persons who multiplied minimum daily allowances to make sure they were properly nourished.

Now the FDA is taking a more positive approach. The new system, the U.S. RDA, or U.S. Recommended Dietary Allowances, is more than just minimum. It includes a safety margin to allow for differences in individual nutrition needs.

Nutritional labeling is voluntary, but if a company decides to use such labeling, it must follow the new regulations. Since it takes time to use up old labels, companies will have until December 31, 1974, before the law takes full effect.
