

## New Seed Catalog Features Stakeless Tomato

The new bush type tomato, Stakeless, was introduced by The University of Delaware in 1971. Its stems are about one inch

thick. The plant bears its fruit close to the stem. It's strong stem and upright growing nature supports the tomatoes above the ground.

The plants of Stakeless tomatoes have dense foliage protecting the fruit from sunburn. It is resistant to blight. Under favorable conditions it grows 18 to 24 inches tall. It eliminates the need for stakes, pruning, tying, etc.

The ripe tomatoes from Stakeless weigh about eight ounces. They're crack resistant, globe shape, firm and ripen to a bright red color. Folks who have sampled Stakeless like their "meatiness" and mild flavor.

This is an excellent variety for gardeners with limited space. They're sure to appeal to home owners with only a small space in their lawn. Or, for planters and tubs placed on patios, etc.
