Not being able to see clearly at intersections is a major factor in many accidents that cause injuries or deaths, reminds the Extension Service Safety Committee of The Pennsylvania State University. Some causes of not being able to see well are weeds, bushes, corn, overgrown shrubbery, corner posts, and road banks. Where possible, late fall and early winter is a good time to remove some of these, the Committee suggests.

classifier since the inception of the program in 1929. Through 1972, 1,479,420 animals have been officially classified."

Cornman has been active in the Registered Holstein business for many years, having been born and raised on a Holstein farm. Following graduation from high school, he farmed with his father and brother until he got married in 1965. Since then he has been operating his own dairy farm with his wife Linda. They have a four-year-old daughter Anita Marie.

As an official Holstein classifier, Cornman has a dual responsibility. The first and foremost objective is classification of eligible animals according to the established rules, procedures and guidelines. Of equal importance is the relationship with the herd owner, that is, classifying animals with accompanying explanation that is easily understood by the owner.

The final classification score that the official classifier places

on an animal is derived exclusively from the four major breakdown areas, General Appearance, Dairy Character, Body and Mammary. The 12 heritable type traits are identified or "described" by code numbers one to five. All code "one's" are desirable traits. All code "two's" are acceptable except for code two under "udder support and floor." All codes three, four and five are undesirable type traits.
